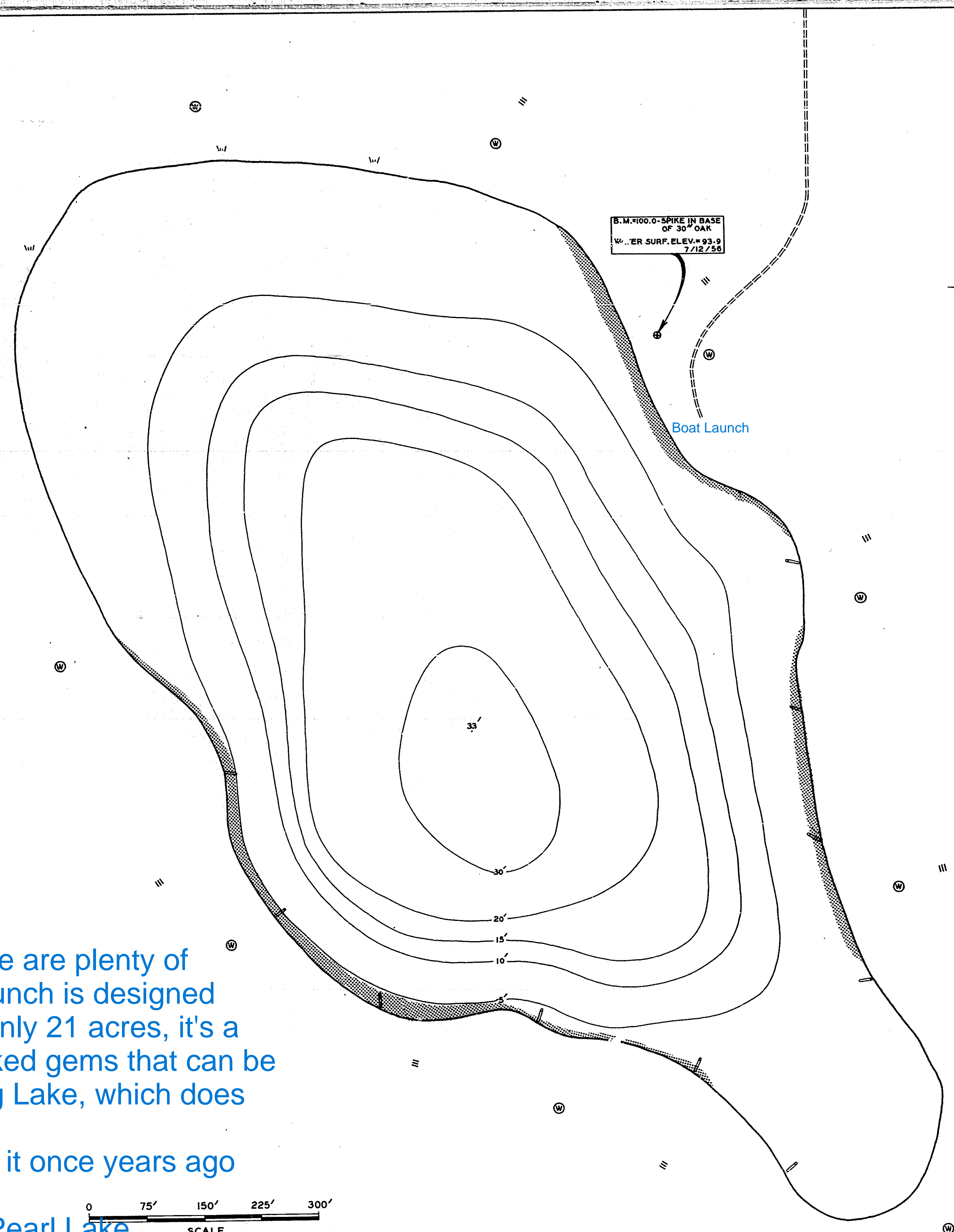

At only 21 acres, it's a pretty small lake but often times it's these overlooked gems that can be worth the effort. Another nearby lake is Armstrong Lake, which does have public access as well.

There are no maps available for this lake. I fished it once years ago and came up short but I've been itching to get back. It looked very promising. Garey Lake, Pearl Lake, Steven's, Herendeene, and Davis Lakes are all smaller lakes and close by.

Hardly any of these lakes receive much fishing pressure!
