

Excellent lake to go and escape the crowds! There are plenty of largemouth bass and bluegills in this lake. The launch is designed more for small boats and carry down access. At only 21 acres, it's a pretty small lake but often times it's these overlooked gems that can be worth the effort. Another nearby lake is Armstrong Lake, which does have public access as well.

There are no maps available for this lake. I fished it once years ago and came up short but I've been itching to get back. It looked very promising. Garey Lake, Pearl Lake, scale Steven's, Herendeene, and Davis Lakes are all smaller lakes and close by.

Hardly any of these lakes receive much fishing pressure!
