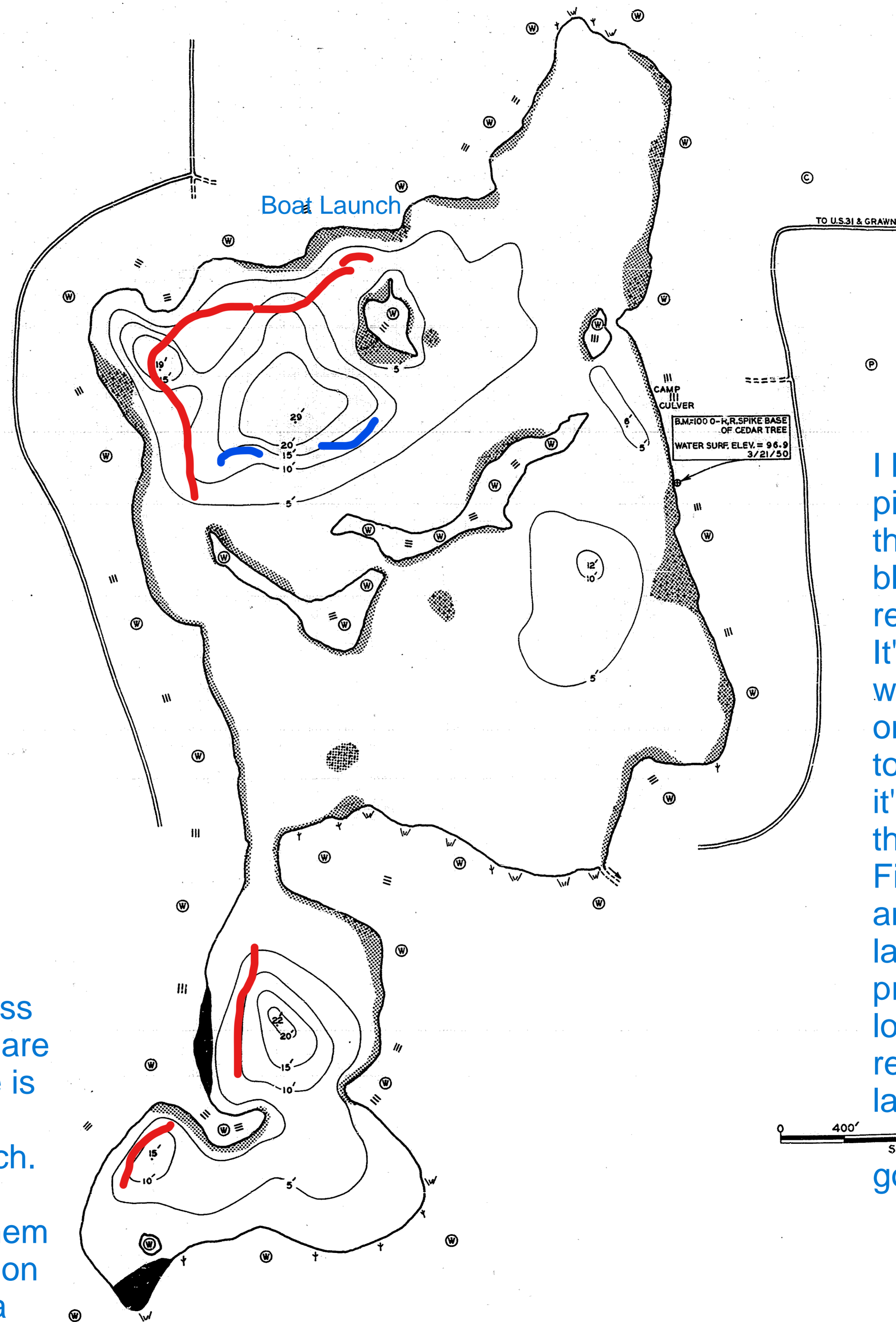

I have done decent on northern pike through the ice so I know they're in there. I fished the blue areas and pulled some respectable fish out. It's fun taking the boat all the way to the old girl scout camp on the south end. Green Lake township recently aquired it so it'll be interesting to see whay their plans are with the property. Fish the lily pads for the bass and bluegill. It's a pretty cool lake with not too much fishing pressure. You're bound to see lots of wildlife from birds, deer, reptiles, etc. Great getaway lake in my opinion plus you may go home with a nice stringer full!

Bass Lake is a great lake to fish if you love bass and bluegill fishing like I do. The areas in red are where I've had my best luck. Most of this lake is very shallow but there are a few deeper spots such as the one off the first island by the launch. Some of my best bluegills have come off this lake. You'll catch a ton of bass and most of them are average size but there are some big bass on this lake. The water is a little dark and it has a mucky bottom but this lake freezes quite good. The only problem is I cannot find the gills through the ice. One would think they'd be in that hole!
