

I've had my best luck for largemouth and smallmouth bass in the red areas. I've found nice perch in the blue areas. Troll or jig the yellow area, the deepest hole, for the lakers. A buddy of mine pulled out an 18 pounder during a tournament I ran! My old boss does really well out there trolling. People are pretty hush hush about their laker fishing out there but the DNR plants thousands every year! There are some good pike in this lake and the bass fishing is phenomenal!
