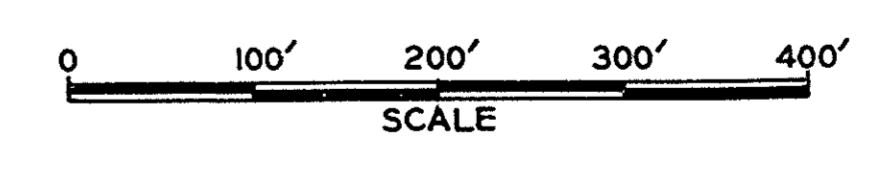
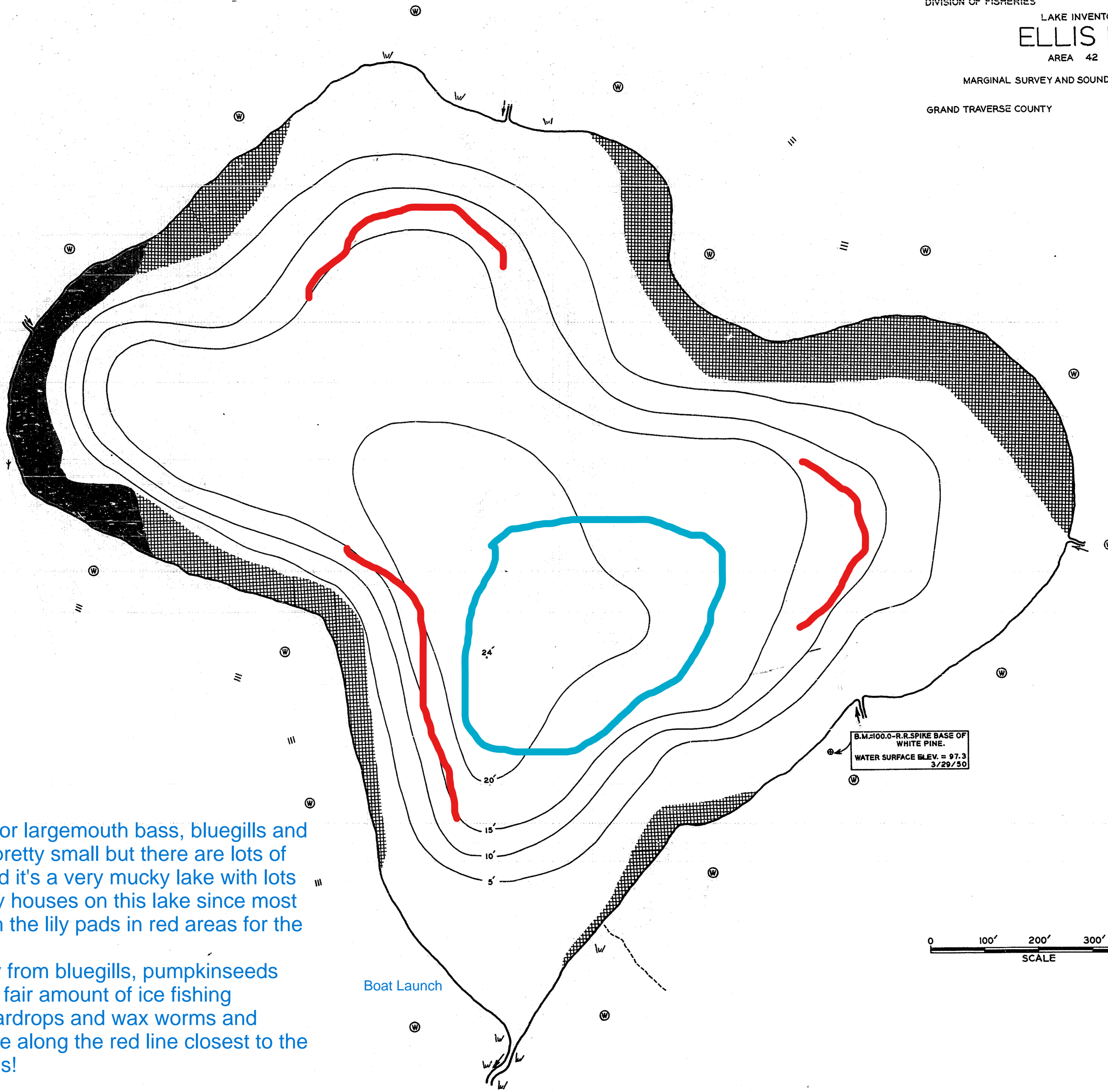

This is a nice and quiet Lake to fish for largemouth bass, bluegills and northern pike. The pike tend to run pretty small but there are lots of them. The launch is a little rough and it's a very mucky lake with lots of lily pads too. There are hardly any houses on this lake since most of Ellis Lake borders state land. Fish the lily pads in red areas for the panfish and bass.

Ellis Lake has a great panfish fishery from bluegills, pumpkinseeds and redears. Therefore it receives a fair amount of ice fishing pressure. Fish the blue area with teardrops and wax worms and you'll find them. Place tip ups for pike along the red line closest to the launch and you'll be busy chasing flags!
