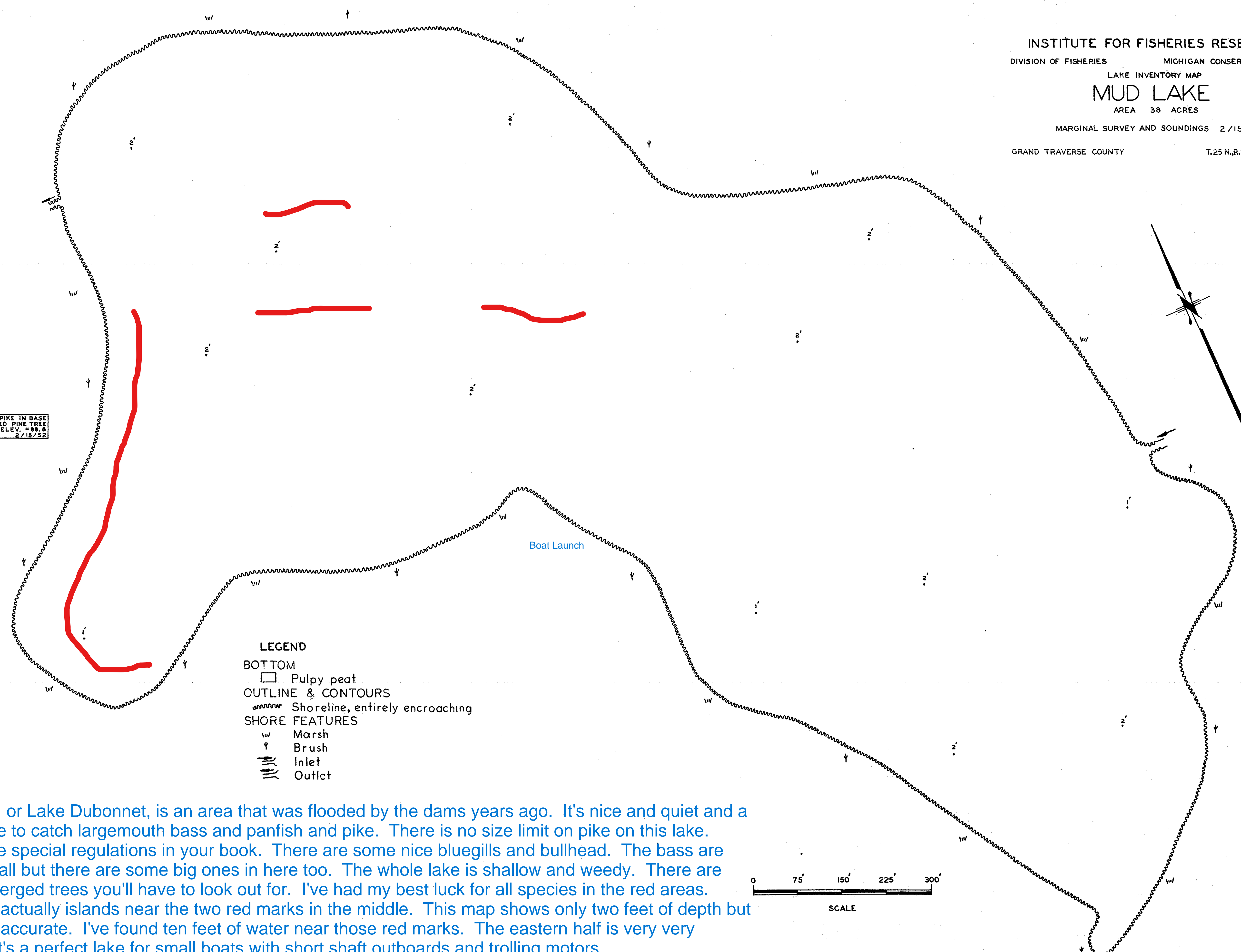
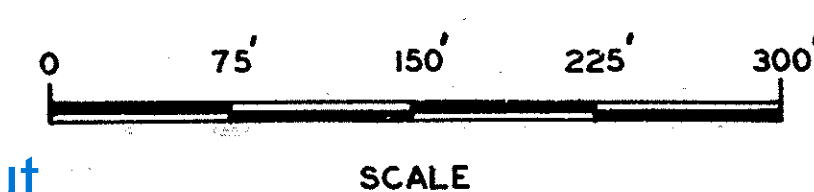


B.M. = 100.0 - R.R. SPIKE IN BASE

Mud Lake, or Lake Dubonnet, is an area that was flooded by the dams years ago. It's nice and quiet and a great place to catch largemouth bass and panfish and pike. There is no size limit on pike on this lake. Look at the special regulations in your book. There are some nice bluegills and bullhead. The bass are mostly small but there are some big ones in here too. The whole lake is shallow and weedy. There are also submerged trees you'll have to look out for. I've had my best luck for all species in the red areas. There are actually islands near the two red marks in the middle. This map shows only two feet of depth but that is not accurate. I've found ten feet of water near those red marks. The eastern half is very very shallow. It's a perfect lake for small boats with short shaft outboards and trolling motors.
