



Spider Lake has great bass fishing. Most of the gills are small but there are some good ones. There's also decent perch and some nice black crappies. Hit the spots in the yellow for panfish for a start. Try the red areas for the bass. It's fun to go into the different coves and fish. Some are shallow for the most part but usually have a few holes. There are a lot of houses and rentals on this lake so it gets crowded in the summer. Troll the blue areas for the northern pike. Hot n Tots of bright color work pretty good. There are a lot of pike. You'll find plenty of undersized pike but a few keepers too. Forty inchers are caught! My best pike on this lake came through the ice. A lot of people ice fish here as it is one of the first lakes to freeze.
