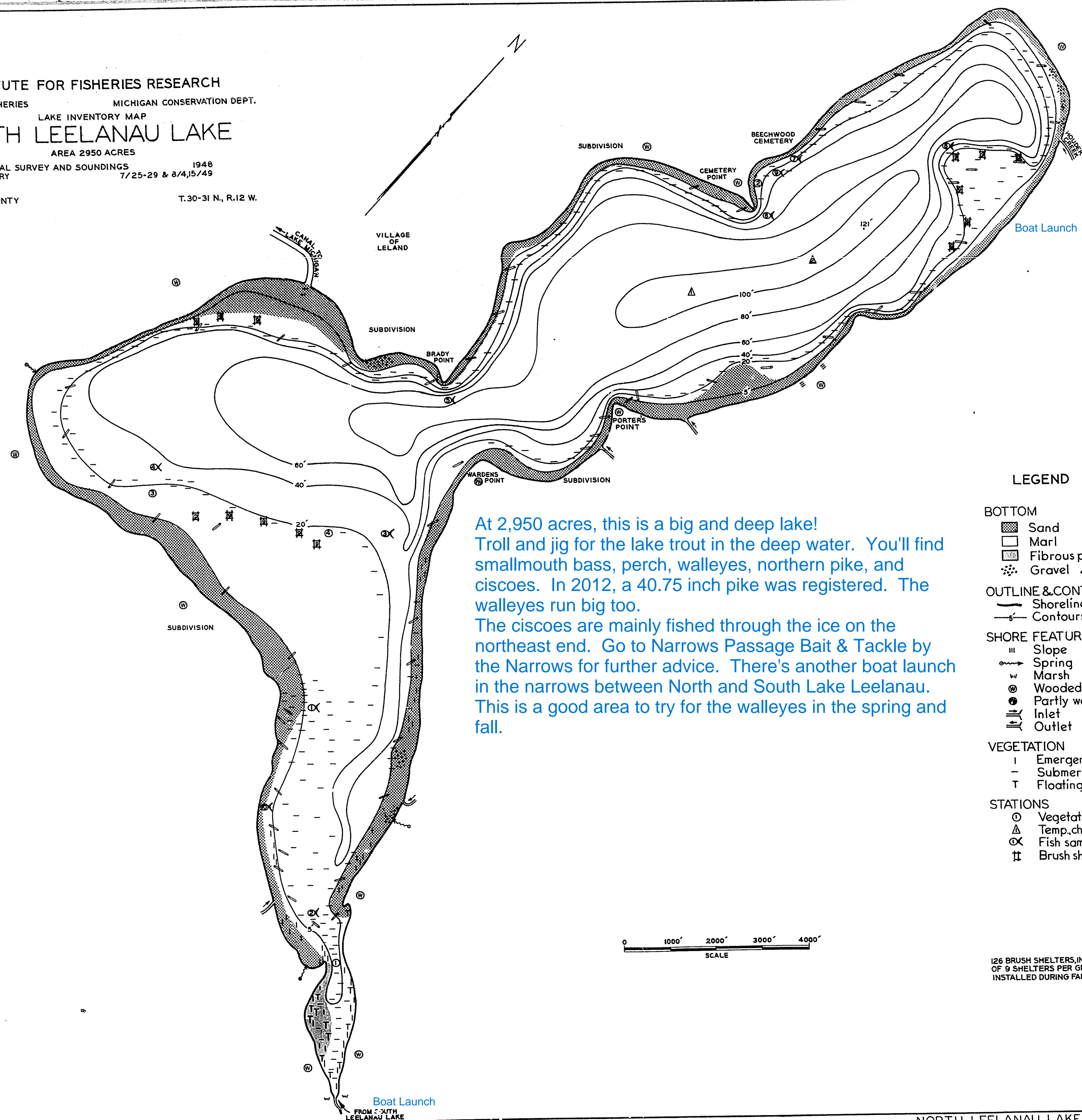


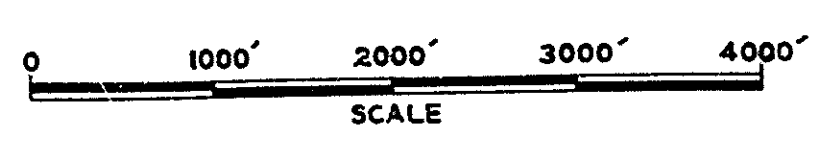

At 2,950 acres, this is a big and deep lake!
 Troll and jig for the lake trout in the deep water. You'll find
 smallmouth bass, perch, walleyes, northern pike, and
 ciscoes. In 2012, a 40.75 inch pike was registered. The
 walleyes run big too.
 The ciscoes are mainly fished through the ice on the
 northeast end. Go to Narrows Passage Bait & Tackle by
 the Narrows for further advice. There's another boat launch
 in the narrows between North and South Lake Leelanau.
 This is a good area to try for the walleyes in the spring and
 fall.
