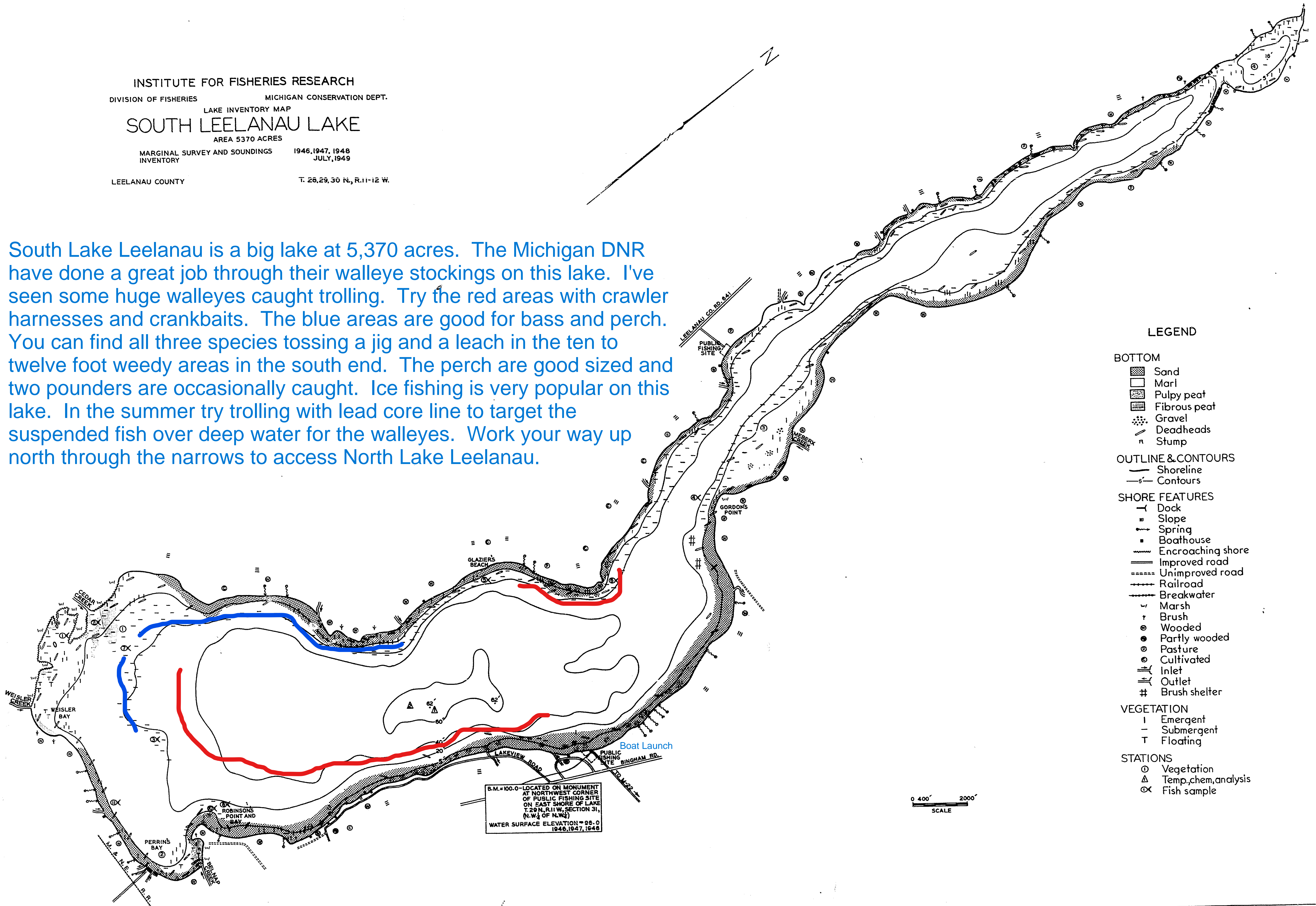

South Lake Leelanau is a big lake at 5,370 acres. The Michigan DNR have done a great job through their walleye stockings on this lake. I've seen some huge walleyes caught trolling. Try the red areas with crawler harnesses and crankbaits. The blue areas are good for bass and perch. You can find all three species tossing a jig and a leach in the ten to twelve foot weedy areas in the south end. The perch are good sized and two pounders are occasionally caught. Ice fishing is very popular on this lake. In the summer try trolling with lead core line to target the suspended fish over deep water for the walleyes. Work your way up north through the narrows to access North Lake Leelanau.
